Creating a Concertina Art Book

The workshop is a continuation* of the basic digital image gel transfer techniques. The Concertina Art Book is another way to display and market your artwork. Transferring your digital images to Arches 88 waterleaf paper and accordion folded creates the art book. A printed aluminum cover will add the finishing touches to your creation. Participants need to bring their ready to print Photoshop files on a flash drive or CD.

Creating accordion book pages

- Transfer technique demonstration using alcohol gel
- Images printed on DASS transfer film with Epson printer
- Transfer images onto Arches 88 waterleaf paper
- Create accordion folds

Creating aluminum cover

- Create custom printed aluminum sheet metal cover
- Assemble Concertina Art Book
